When you join the 'AS in GB', by completing the membership application form, we will collect and use your personal data (your name, gender, postal address, phone number, email address, date of birth).

We use 'Legitimate Interest' as our legal basis for processing this personal data.

We use the personal data you provide to fulfil your membership. This includes posting / emailing our quarterly newsletter, providing information about our Annual General Meeting, posting / emailing our annual membership contribution form, posting / emailing event notifications and catalogues of anthroposophical publications.

The 'AS in GB' is part of the 'General Anthroposophical Society', who are based at the Goetheanum in Dornach, Switzerland. We do not share your personal information with a third party.

We will only use and store your personal data for as long as it is required for the purpose of membership administration.
